Vehicle Information: Arrival time to draped area: no later than 9:00 am on Wednesday 6-28

This is an outdoor public parking lot which will be draped off for the show. No display numbers will be assigned for outdoor vehicles, parking is first come – first served. Vehicles are allowed in the general (non-draped) area any time before and after the show so you may arrive the day before and stay after the expo. 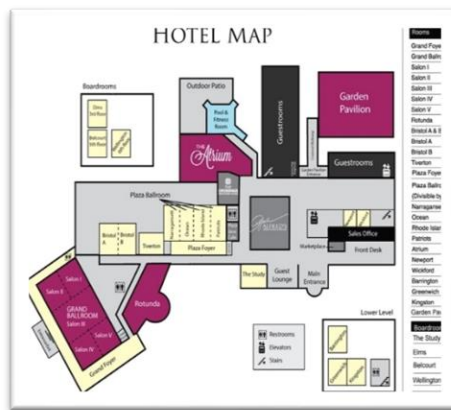
